To earn the CFA charter, candidates must pass three sequential, six-hour examinations over two to four years. The three levels of the CFA Program test a wide range of investment topics, including ethical and professional standards, fixed-income analysis, alternative and derivative investments, and portfolio management and wealth planning. In addition, CFA charterholders must have at least four years of acceptable professional experience in the investment decision-making process and must commit to abide by, and annually reaffirm, their adherence to the CFA Institute Code of Ethics and Standards of Professional Conduct.

Certified Financial Planning (CFP®) Certificant. Issued by the Certified Financial Planner Board of Standards, Inc. in December 2016.

To earn the CFP® designation, candidates must have a bachelor's degree or higher from an accredited college or university and have 3 years of full-time personal financial planning experience. Candidates must also complete a CFP® board registered program or other qualifying designation in addition to successfully completing a 10-hour examination. CFP® professionals must complete 30 hours of continuing education every two years.
