Candidates must also complete a CFP® board registered program or other qualifying designation in addition to successfully completing a 10-hour examination. CFP® professionals must complete 30 hours of continuing education every two years.

Ms. Clark received the Chartered Retirement Planning Counselor (CRPC®) designation in August 2010. The CRPC is a professional designation awarded by the College for Financial Planning to individuals who complete a study program and pass a final multiple-choice examination. The study program to become a CRPC covers the entire retirement planning process, including meeting multiple financial objectives, sources of retirement income, personal savings, employer sponsored retirement plans, income taxes, retirement cash flow, asset management and estate planning. All designees have agreed to adhere to Standards of Professional Conduct and are subject to a disciplinary process. CRPC professionals renew their designation every two years by completing 16 hours of continuing education, reaffirming adherence to the Standards of Professional Conduct and complying with self-disclosure requirements.
